CODE OF CONDUCT

GUEST BEHAVIOR

Guests are required to wear proper attire (as determined by Museum personnel in their sole discretion) while on the Museum property. Shirts and shoes must be worn at all times.

To preserve the artifacts on display, guests are prohibited from touching any of the exhibits or displays.

Except in designated areas, no eating or drinking is allowed at the Museum.

The Museum reserves the right to refuse entry to guests who appear to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs.

Guests are not allowed to create or engage in any activity that could be described as a performance, create a media event or photo opportunity on Museum property or give tours of the exhibitions without prior written approval from the Museum.

Offensive, abusive or threatening language or objectionable behavior (sexual or otherwise) towards Museum personnel or other guests is considered harassment and is strictly prohibited.

Excessive cell phone use, video calls or playing loud audio or video on personal devices, or any other activities deemed distracting to other guests is not permitted.

Guests are not permitted to bring large bags, backpacks or umbrellas into the galleries. A complimentary coat check is provided.

ACCESSIBILITY

Guests who rely on service animals or who are training service animals may bring them into the Museum, provided that the animals remain leashed. Pets are not permitted.

It is with regret that at the current time, only the Retail Store and Bar are wheelchair accessible.

PHOTOGRAPHY

Guests may use small hand-held devices to take photographs and videos (without flash) in the Museum galleries providing it does not interfere with the experience or enjoyment of other guests. Selfie sticks and tripods are not permitted.

Guests with commercial-grade video or photography equipment, and/or guests intending on using photos and videos for commercial use must seek prior approval in advance.

IN ACCORDANCE WITH STATE AND CITY LAW

Smoking and vaping, including the use of e-cigarettes, is strictly prohibited anywhere on Museum property or inside any exhibit area.

It is illegal to deface, damage, mutilate or destroy Museum property, artifacts, exhibits or equipment. Handling artifacts, exhibits or equipment without the presence and permission of a Museum staff member is prohibited.

Indecent exposure, lewd or sexual acts or behavior is strictly prohibited.

Fighting, provoking a fight, or engaging in disorderly or boisterous conduct is strictly prohibited.

SECURITY POLICY

Guests may be asked to leave the Museum if they violate the Museum Code of Conduct or display behavior that Museum or security personell deem to be unsafe, unsavory or offensive.
